## CHIICAGO PLAN COMMISSION COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PROCUREMENT SERVICES REGARDING MINORITY AND WOMEN-OWNED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES

Pursuant to Executive Order 2017-2, the Department of Planning and Development (DPD) strongly encourages an applicant seeking planned development approval from the Chicago Plan Commission to hire Minority and Women-Owned Business Enterprises (M/WBEs), as certified by the City of Chicago and/or Cook County, and to meet the MBE participation goal of 26% and the WBE participation goal of 6%.

A list of minority and women business Assist Agencies, many of whose members are certified M/WBEs, is maintained by the City's Department of Procurement Services (DPS) and is available on the DPS website and through the following link:

An applicant for planned development approval, as part of its good faith effort to hire M/WBEs and to achieve the M/WBE participation goals, should send a letter to each association on the aforementioned Assist Agency list that maintains a directory of certified firms and invite the association's members to inquire about participation in the project.
