

Chicago Moves will provide relief for Chicago residents struggling with transportation expenses. Chicago Moves aims to help combat spiking costs of gas and rising inflation by providing \$12.5 million in relief funding for 150,000 disadvantaged Chicagoans through \$150 prepaid gas cards for up to 50,000 drivers and \$50 prepaid transit cards for up to 100,000 transit riders.

Prepaid Gas Cards

- 50,000 \$150 prepaid cards for eligible Chicago residents citywide
- Use of the card will be limited to purchasing gas at the pump at filing stations located in City of Chicago

Prepaid Transit Cards

- 100,000 \$50 prepaid transit cards for eligible Chicago residents
- The transit cards may be used to purchase fares for public transit purposes in Chicago

How Will Prepaid Cards Be Allocated to City Residents?

- Recipients will be chosen based upon a monthly lottery and eligibility requirements below
- Applicants for earlier rounds who are not selected will be automatically entered into future rounds
 75% of prepaid cards will prioritize residents in community areas that face higher mobility hardship (see map on attached page)
- The remaining 25% of prepaid cards will be distributed citywide, by lottery

How Can I Apply for a Card?

- Online: apply at <u>Chicago.Gov/ChicagoMoves</u>
- In-Person: Paper applications can be filled and submitted at all Chicago Public Libraries locations
- Applicants can only apply for one of the prepaid gas cards or prepaid transit cards
- Only one application per household will be considered

Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be a Chicago resident
- Be at least 18 years old
- Have a current and valid City sticker with correct mailing information for their vehicle (only required for gas card applicants)
- Have a household income at or below the Area Median Income for Chicago

• The Lottery will be conducted in the second week of May – September. To be considered for each month's lottery, applications must be submitted by the first day of that month.
