#### **COVID-19 Pandemic Impacts**

In the first three months of the pandemic **3.3 Million** small businesses were forced to shut their doors. The number of Black businesses declined by **41%** between February and April 2020, according to the Federal Reserved of New York



\$19.1 M >40 funders have provided grant funding and TA support



1,690 Small businesses in Cook County received

**\$10,000** in small business grants

### Levels of Service for Transactional (non-litigation) Legal Assistance

#### **Brief Advice**

-30 minute consultation, typically after review of publications or webinars on the legal topic

Limited Representation -more than 30 minutes, less than 2 hours -review of a 1-2pp contract -questions when additional research is needed to answer a brief advice question

Direct Representation (Application Required) -placement with a volunteer attorney for specifically scoped out pro bono representation
