


## **BIKING IN CHICAGO**

- There is a growing interest and need for bikeways in several neighborhoods not well served by the bikeway network
- Divvy bikeshare is <u>expanding citywide</u> and experienced record breaking ridership in 2021
- Biking won't be a useful transportation option until it provides convenient access to all the places people want and need to go.
- We want to build a connected network of bikeways in South Lawndale

#### **South Lawndale**

- Low density of bikeways
- 6.5 miles of existing bikeways (8% of streets)





## **NEIGHBORHOOD BIKE NETWORK PROGRAM**


#### 2021 program partnered with community members in:

- North Lawndale


Installed 20 miles of bike routes in 2021

































## **NEIGHBORHOOD TASKFORCE**

- ▶ Identify ~10 miles of bikeways to install in 2022 & 2023 in South Lawndale
- Identify long-term projects (2023 and beyond)
- Develop other recommendations to making biking safe, convenient, and appealing to the neighborhood
