





Testing remains high, with positivity now under 5%




Test positivity is the number of positive tests divided by all tests performed (Source: INEDSS).


New COVID-19 cases in Chicago are declining




Most new COVID-19 cases in adults age 18-49; seeing increases in Chicagoans age 80y+



New COVID-19 case rates remain highest in Black Chicagoans




Most new COVID-19 cases are now on the south side




Increases in COVID-19 hospitalizations in Chicago have slowed (general and ICU); we have adequate capacity



Recent **COVID-19 hospitalizations** by Chicago zip code (Mar 21-Apr 17)




Recent **COVID-19 deaths** by Chicago zip code (in 2021)

Daily COVID-19 Chicago resident deaths and 7-day rolling average by day of death






Population Coverage by Age

Percent of population with at least one dose of vaccine


Percent of population with a completed series





At Least One Dose by ZIP, Percent of Population







