

 Less than 15 daily cases per 100k


All other U.S. Territories are categorized as yellow


Chicago COVID-19 case rates increased to **90 cases/day (3.3 per 100,000 per day)**; still in the **lower risk** category but increased from a low of 34 cases/day in June



# Chicago COVID-19 Test Positivity Rate: **1.5%**. Continues to meet the definition of controlled transmission risk, but increased from a low of **0.4%** in June 2021








# In the last month (our best to date): 136 Chicago residents hospitalized with COVID-19 and 33 Chicago residents died from COVID-19


96-97% of COVID-19 hospitalizations and deaths in Chicago since January have been in people who were NOT fully vaccinated



# Recent COVID-19 hospitalizations by Chicago zip code (Jun 27<sup>th</sup> to Jul 10<sup>th</sup>) n=63




# Recent COVID-19 deaths (May 1 to July 13, 2021) by Chicago zip code







# Two-thirds of eligible Chicagoans have received at least the 1<sup>st</sup> dose of COVID-19 vaccine






# Continuing to work on vaccinating **Black Non-Latinx** and **Latinx** Chicagoans

# Taking COVID-19 seriously at Lollapalooza



- Get vaccinated!
- Wear a mask if you are unvaccinated
- **Reminder from the FBI:** If you make or buy a fake COVID-19 vaccination record card, you endanger yourself and those around you, and you are breaking the law

## BEFORE THE EVENT:

- ★ Get vaccinated! Getting vaccinated now will still give you some protection for Lollapalooza weekend – though if you are not Fully Vaccinated, you will still need a negative test.
- ★ Bring your vaccine card or proof of negative COVID-19 test within the last 72 hours
- ★ Do not attend Lollapalooza if you have symptoms of COVID-19 even if you have been vaccinated


