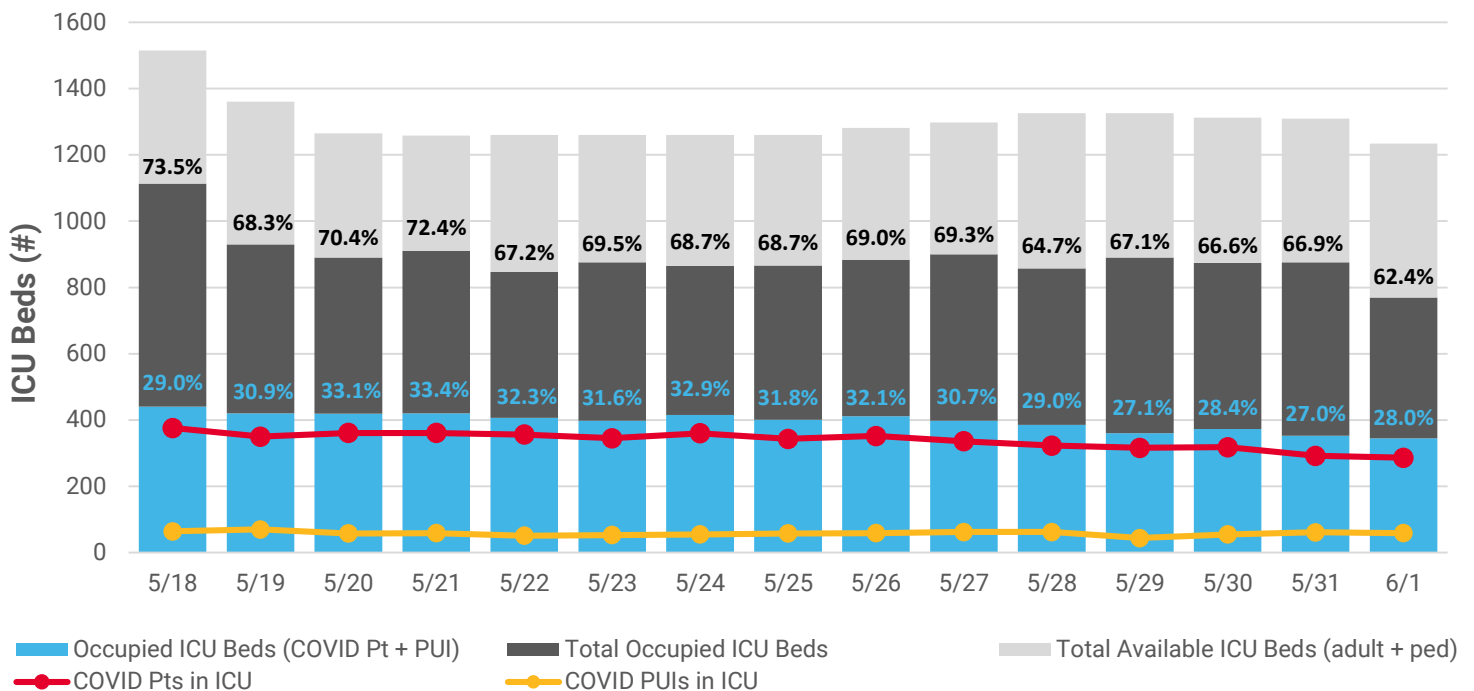

Daily Hospital Bed (ICU and Acute/Non-ICU) Capacity, June 1 2359h

Note: Beginning 4/24/2020, the definition of ICU beds changed as requested by HHS. Beginning 5/7/2020, hospitals report patients and PUI in non-ICU beds separately. The McCormick Alternate Treatment Facility Hall C is closed as of 5/8/2020. Hospitals began reporting ICU surge capacity as part of total capacity on 5/18/2020.

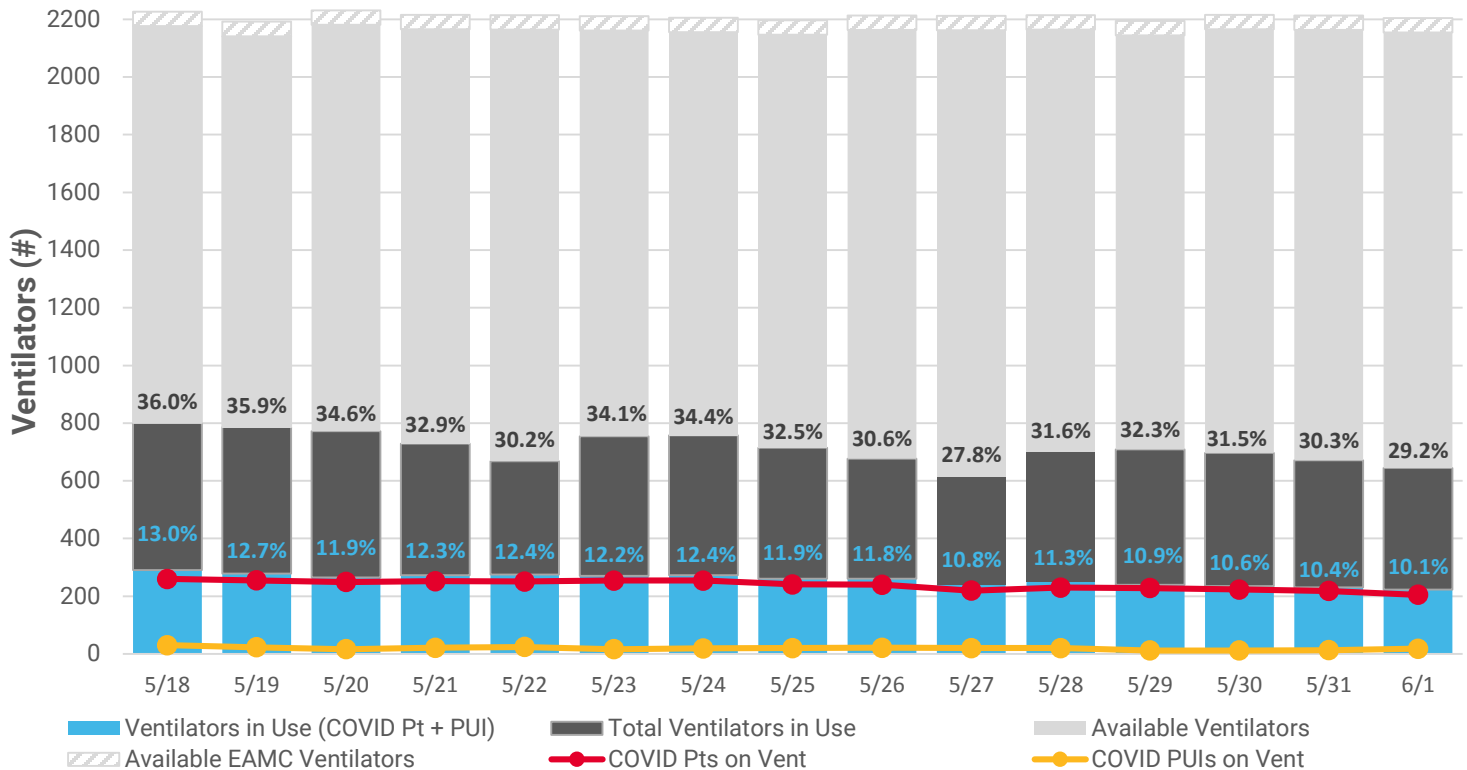

Daily Ventilator Capacity, June 1 2359h

Note: Beginning 4/24/2020, ventilator counts include all full-functioning mechanical ventilators, BiPAP, anesthesia machines and portable/transport ventilators. Previously, BiPAP, anesthesia machines and portable/transport ventilators were counted as surge. On 05/07/2020, hospitals were given updated reporting instructions and specialty hospitals began reporting availability. These changes may have impacted ventilator availability data.
