Resilience Across the Disaster Cycle

- Prepare
 - Programs designed to foster behavior change and community-wide culture of preparedness
 - Preparedness integrated into Response & Recovery
 - Close coordination with partners in preparedness efforts

Resilience Across the Disaster Cycle (cont.)

- Respond
 - Coordinate closely with partners
 - Strengthen utilization of local volunteers
 - MARCs as a standard practice to bridge from response to recovery
- Recover
 - Enhanced collaboration with partners during client's recovery
 - Incorporate resilience into recovery "When Resources Allow"
