Application Requirements

CDOT Intake Meeting

Signed Plans or Diagrams

- Certified drawings stamped by an Illinois Certified architect or engineer (People Spots and vertical installations)
- · Detailed diagrams showing location of tables and chairs
- Structural drawings for vertical installations
- Aerial map showing street / alley closures and proposed re-route plans

Proof of Community Support

- Local Aldermen
- Local / Sponsoring Organizations
- Adjacent Businesses and Residents

Certificate of Liability Insurance

- Policy Limits
- Commercial General Liability Each occurrence \$1 mil / General Aggregate \$2 mil
- Automobile Liability \$1 million
- Worker's Compensation and Employer's Liability \$1 million
- Insurance Endorsements (Commercial and Automobile Liability only) specifically stating endorsement of the City of Chicago
- City of Chicago Economic Disclosure Statement
- State of Illinois Certificate of Good Standing

Signed Legal Use Agreement


- Term Up to 3 Years
- States City of Chicago Indemnification & Insurance Requirements
- Grants Non-Exclusive Use of the Public Way for Requested Purpose (i.e., People Spot)
- Stipulates Grantees Responsibilities
 - Construction
 - Operation
 - Maintenance
 - · Removal / Storage
 - Public Way Restoration

CDOT Permits

- \$75 Make Way for People Permit (for use of the public way)
- Occupy the Public Right of Way Permit (for construction and installation)
 - Allows for vehicle to occupy the curb during construction
 - No fee (include MWFP permit number on application)



Application Steps, Deadline & Timelines



- Applications accepted on a rolling basis
- People Spot applications should be submitted by the end of February to accommodate installation in May of the same application year.
- Approximate timeline for approvals 2 months
- Timeline for approval can be less depending on project complexity
