

Who We Learned From.








What Methods.

 - a) Working Question #1: How can we define equity and racial equity?
 - Working Question #2: What should a Year of Healing look like for Chicago and what values should support it?
 - c) Conversations transcribed by Local Voices Network
- **3. Analyses of feedback** by Office of Equity and Racial Justice, Department of Planning, and Equity Council working group.
- 4. Community feedback on final draft.
- 5. Adoption as the official "City of Chicago Equity Statement of Principles"



is defined in a variety of ways. In thinking of how Chicago should define **resiliency**, please rank the words below in the order they are most important to you:




Resilient Chicago





Resilient City Definition

A city's resilience is defined by the ability of its individuals, institutions, businesses, and systems within the community to survive, adapt, and grow despite the chronic stresses or acute shocks it experiences. A truly resilient city is not only expected to perform well in good times but also recover expediently after challenges.





Launch a Year of Healing

Our goal is to catalyze momentum to advance racial healing in Chicago by amplifying and connecting existing initiatives and nurturing and promoting new initiatives across Chicago.

Synthesizing the feedback from the TWH summit, we will develop a **Year of Healing** action framework that will guide us as we spearhead signature activities, coordinate resources to support the growth of engagement and provide a platform to increase visibility of aligned efforts.



Adopt an Equity Statement of Principles

An Equity Statement of Principles is a foundational document that serves to provide a common, unified language and understanding of equity as both a process and a desired outcome. The goal is that this statement will live to be embraced by the entire city enterprise and serve several purposes, including but not limited to guiding the work of the citywide planning initiative, We Will Chicago; City department strategic planning; City procurement and hiring practices; City grant-making priorities; and recovery initiatives.


