

1. Please describe the major features of this project.

The major feature of this project includes the removal of contaminated soil from the property recently acquired by the Chicago Department of Aviation (CDA).

This JOC Program was developed to remove Underground Storage Tanks theoughout the City as well as perfrom remedial activities of contaminated sites in support of redevelopment. The Scope of Work and size of the project described above fits inside the initial design of the JOC Program. CDA has requested to utilize this JOC for the removal of contaminated soil from a recently acquired parcel for the Midway Airport perimeter expansion. CDA is trying to get the property redeveloped and control the potential for soil contamination from spreading off site. As such, this is a time sensitive project.
